CDC GUIDELINES OUR SOLUTIONS

PHASE 1 DEVELOP YOUR PLAN	Determine what needs to be cleaned.	Our disinfecting program incorporates CDC best practices and includes various levels of intensity to accommodate different facility types and client needs. We provide everything from disinfecting touchpoints to disinfecting entire facilities with ATP-tested and validated results.
	Determine how areas will be disinfected.	We are experienced in cleaning different facility and surface types. We will work with you to determine what is the best method for disinfecting and what surfaces should be focal points.
	Consider the resources and equipment needed.	One of the benefits of hiring a professional cleaning contractor is that we supply everything needed to clean your facility, from the equipment to the disinfectants to the trained professional cleaners.
PHASE 2: IMPLEMENT	Clean visibly dirty surfaces with soap and water prior to disinfection.	Our disinfecting process includes a pre-cleaning service that removes the dirt, debris, and other particles so that our disinfecting process can be more effective.

Chemicals can be dangerous if used improperly, which is one of the reasons having a professional cleaning company care for your facility can be so beneficial. All of our teams receive extensive training on proper chemical use and safety.
