who should get a flu shot?

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends everyone 6 months of age and older get a flu shot each year.



what does the flu shot do?

The flu shot reduces your risk of getting the flu by creating antibodies that build a stronger immune response to the flu virus. This helps to protect you from getting sick or reduces the severity of the illness.



why should I get a flu shot?

The flu can be very dangerous and cause a serious illness, even if you are healthy. Getting a flu shot each year protects you and those around you by reducing your risk of getting the flu.



where can I get a flu shot?
